

Training at Daycare

- 1. **Training handouts**: These are the guidelines I have been using as I trained your pet, working on the behaviors which we previously discussed. They provide a step by step process on how to get these behaviors on your own now that you've picked your dog up.

General Dog Training Tips:

- You have 3 seconds to praise good behavior or else your dog doesn't connect the behavior they did with the praise. Make sure when training that you have treats ready and if you don't have treats, be ready to pet and sound very happy and excited.
- When your dog is misbehaving, ignore them. Any form of attention will be seen as positive for your dog, even if you're yelling "No" at them. By ignoring the bad behaviors and praising the good, your dog will understand better what makes you happy.
- To dogs, there are 3 major forms of attention which come in the forms of **Verbal** attention (Excited praise or saying "no", it's still attention), **Physical** attention (Petting or pushing your dog away is physical contact they crave) and **Eye** contact (even when you're giving them an angry stare, it's still attention)
