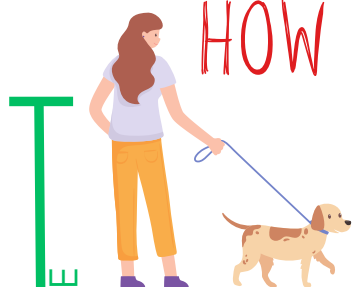


HOW TO INTRODUCE YOUR DOGS



Walk dogs parallel to each other
Do not pressure them to meet
You may need to repeat this
over a couple of days



Gradually decrease distance
between dogs if they are okay
Chat with each other to lessen
tension



Introduce dogs in neutral
territory

Your yard is NOT neutral

You're looking for a place
that is quiet and calm

Avoid places that can cause
extreme emotions like a dog
park or a vet clinic's yard

Go to a park or a quiet
sports field



Avoid having toys or chew
treats loose around the house

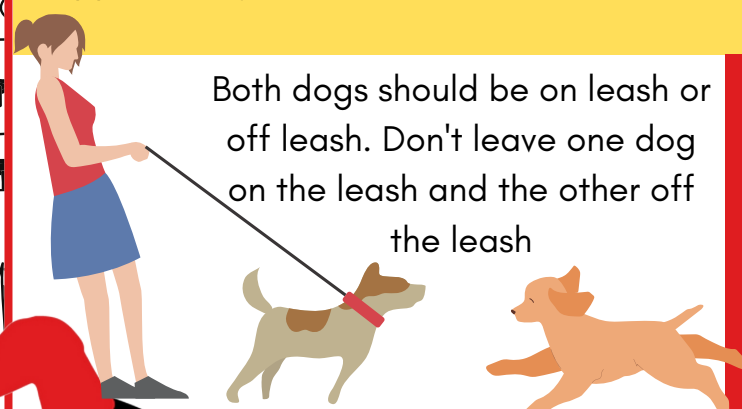
Make sure both dogs get
individual time without worrying
about the other dog stealing the
attention



Dogs can get jealous and that
can lead to resenting the other
dog or even aggression

Don't give the new dog more attention than your current dog

Avoid face to face introductions
Approaching head on can seem direct and aggressive



Both dogs should be on leash or
off leash. Don't leave one dog
on the leash and the other off
the leash

Keep both dogs on leashes with plenty of
space while inside the house to allow
them to get used to each other



Start across the room and
get closer only when they
are comfortable
