



Advanced Class Homework

Unlike Beginner and Intermediate class, advanced class comes with actual homework for you to do beyond simply practicing the behaviors we learn. To ensure your dog has enough experience to pass the test, it's time to take it to the real world! Each week, you will find specific requests from your trainer. These can be texted, emailed, or sent via Facebook messenger to your trainer. Please make sure you get them done before the next week's class so that your trainer knows you have practiced.

Week One Done

- A photo of your dog in a "sit" at a public location
- A photo of your dog on their "place" mat at home
- A quick video of you practicing "finish" and "heel" inside the house

Week Two Done

- A photo of your dog in their "place" mat with distance in your home
- A quick video of your dog practicing "finish" and walking a figure eight pattern indoors or in a calm outdoor setting such as your back yard

Week Three Done

- A quick video of your dog practicing "heel" in a non-busy public location for 10 human steps
- A picture of your dog practicing "stay" near a doorframe or corner inside your home
- A picture of your dog on their "place" mat across the room

Week Four Done

- A quick video of your dog practicing "heel" in a mildly busy public location for 15 human steps
- A picture of your dog relaxing while somebody else holds their leash
- A quick video of your dog in a "stay" with your leash fully extended in a public location

Week Five Done

- A quick video of your dog in a "stay" as you walk to a door and open it
- A picture of your dog relaxing while somebody else holds their leash in public and at a distance
- A picture of your dog in a "down" with the leash fully extended in a public location
