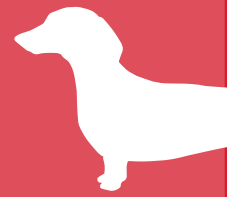


# WIND ISSUES

When there is no or low levels of wind in an area your dog recognizes and uses those scents to approximate how near or far other animals are.

This information is used to identify how close any potential dangers or triggers. They can also identify sounds and their directions.



When it is windy or gusty, scents are carried on the wind and in gusts. Your dog is now receiving MANY more scents and it is very difficult for your dog to pinpoint the direction they are coming from. Dogs can become overwhelmed by different smells and cents that are now coming to them at different directions.

This causes an overwhelming amount of information that your dog may struggle with. They also now have MANY more sounds surrounding them and they struggle to identify the direction.
